

**RESOLUTION IN SUPPORT OF BALLOT MEASURES 1A AND 1B
TO PRESERVE ADAMS COUNTY OPEN SPACE FUNDING**

WHEREAS, Adams County is one of the top counties in the nation for job growth and is projected to become the third largest county in Colorado, making it of utmost importance for the County to responsibly plan for the projected growth;

WHEREAS, Adams County Open Space has referred a ballot measure to the 2020 ballot proposing to extend the existing sales taxes in Adams County for (1) creating, improving and maintaining parks, trails, recreation facilities and open space (Issue 1A) and (2) road, bridge and facilities (Issue 1B) to ensure responsible growth planning and management;

WHEREAS, the ballot measure proposes to protect wetlands, rivers and streams, ease traffic congestion, maintain and improve roads and bridges, preserve land that protects water quality, protect open space to limit sprawl, and maintain and improve parks without raising taxes;

WHEREAS, the residents of Hyland Hills Park and Recreation District have benefited from millions of dollars from Adams County Open Space to provide both active and passive open space and recreational facilities;

WHEREAS, the funding Hyland Hills Park and Recreation District receives from Adams County Open Space supports parks, recreation, open space and community facilities and programs that encourage participants to engage in health and wellness activities and promotes a healthy lifestyle;


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of Directors of the Hyland Hills Park and Recreation District, as follows;

The Board of Directors of Hyland Hills Park and Recreation District supports Adams County Open Space Ballot Issues 1A and 1B and encourages a vote of "yes" for both measures on the ballot in the November 2020 Adams County Colorado General Election.
